## **Overview**

Yilan is a perfect destination to plan your summer vacation with your family. Circa 1996, Yilan has hosted the International Children's Folklore & Folkgames Festival every summer from July through August, and remains one of the main attractions of the season.

On the first day of your tour, your tour guide will greet and meet with you at your Taipei hotel. Then, you will travel to Yilan via Hsuehshan Tunnel, the longest tunnel in Taiwan. You will have almost a full day at Dongshan River Water Park to enjoy the fun of water facilities and the variety of shows presented by different performers around the world. In the evening, you will visit Luodong Night Market, one of the best places for shopping and dining.

On the second day, you will head towards Hualien, the largest county in Taiwan. You will visit the famed Taroko National Park. Taroko means "magnificent and beautiful" in the indigenous Truku language. Its breathtaking views surely will not disappoint! Your tour continue on to Qixingtan, one of the most beautiful beaches in Taiwan.

On the last day, you will have a chance to experience the traditional lifestyle of Taiwan largest aboriginal tribe, Amis. You are going to visit Cidal Hunter School where you can learn the traditional ecological knowledge of the Amis tribe. You will not miss the authentic aboriginal cuisine at the hunter school before heading back to Taipei.

## Yilan International Children's Folklore & Folkgames Festival

# Luodong Night Market

Night market is the unique night life style of Taiwanese, you may taste all kinds of delicacy in the market. Especially in Luodong Night Market, here are some local snack that you can not miss out! Smoked duck, salty rice noodle, and Yilan Scallion Pancake so on.

# Taroko National Park

Taroko National Park is one of eight national parks in Taiwan and was named after the Taroko Gorge, the landmark gorge of the park. Taroko, means "magnificent and beautiful" in the Truku language of the Truku indigenous tribe. This is one of the largest naturally enclosed spaces in the world, spanning 2,300 feet long, 1,300 feet wide, and at least 230 feet high. Taroko Gorge and its surrounding area are well known for their abundant supply of marble.

# Qingshui Cliff

Qingshui Cliff, situated between Heren and Chongde on the Su-Hua Highway, creating a magnificent scene. It stretches more than 21km and rises vertically from the Pacific Ocean with an average height of over 800m. The route along the Qingshui Cliff is the only coastal road in Taroko National Park.

## Cidal Hunter School

Cidal Hunter School is located at Hualien County. You can experience the lifestyle and traditional knowledge of Amis tribe. Besides, you can taste the traditional Amis cuisine afterwards.
